

Dear VSP Participant:

Our records indicate that you are enrolled in the Vision Service Plan (VSP) for the 2009 plan year.

Please note, for this plan, participants do not receive ID cards. Beginning January 1, 2009, your DePaul employee ID number will be the identifier associated with your enrollment record at VSP. This is an enhancement from previous years, in which your Social Security Number was used to identify your record. If you participated in VSP in prior years, your historical records will still be identified under your Social Security Number.

When you visit an eye care specialist or vision provider, all you need to do is provide your DePaul employee ID number (located on your DePaul staff or faculty ID card) to the vision provider. If your covered dependent, spouse, Second Domiciled Adult (SDA), or SDA's children visit a vision provider, their benefit information will be located under your employee ID, as the subscriber. If you do not have your employee ID number available, the provider should be able to locate your record using your name and birth date.
